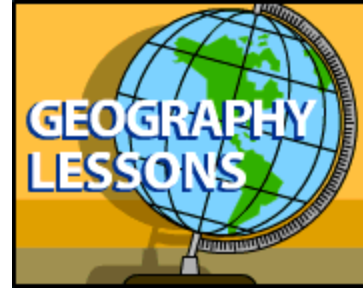


Where in the World?
